## MILITARY RIFLE MATCH

Stillwater Rifle & Pistol Club is hosting sanctioned CMP Games matches. This is a fun match organized to make it easy even for the first timer to participate. Rifles to be used include: Springfield, Military Vintage Bolt Rifle, Garand, Unlimited Garand, and Modern Military Rifle.

**Date and Time:** September 15, 2018 (Saturday). Firing starts at 9:00 a.m. You must arrive no later than 8:15 a.m.

**Registration**: Download the registration form from www.srpc.info, fill out the fillable pdf form, email the completed form to srpcsecretary@gmail.com, then mail a printed form with payment (check) to Stillwater Rifle & Pistol Club, 601 S. Washington, P.M.B. 182, Stillwater, OK 74074. Maximum number of participants is 20.

**Location & Directions to the Range:** Stillwater Rifle & Pistol Club is located on the west side of Lake McMurtry. Detailed instructions of the location can be downloaded from www.srpc.info.

**Eligibility:** Anyone 14 years of age or older can participate. You do not need to be a member of the NRA, CMP or SR&PC. All competitors must have a notarized "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" on file at the sponsoring club or present at registration. The form can be downloaded from either www.srpc.info or thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Affidavit.pdf.

**Entry Fee**: \$15 for non-SRPC members, \$10 for SRPC members, \$5 for Juniors (18 and under)

**Rules:** Current Edition of CMP Rules will be followed. You may download "2016 4th Edition of the CMP Competition Rules for CMP Games Rifle and Pistol Matches" from thecmp.org/competitions/cmp-competitions-rulebooks.

**Course of Fire**: All shots are fired at SR-1 targets at 100 yards. Participants must provide their own ammunition (minimum 35 rounds).

- Stage 1 Slow fire, prone, 5 sighting shots followed by 10 record shots, time limit of 15 minutes. Shooter must inform scorekeeper before starting record shots.
- Stage 2 Rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 shots in 80 seconds.
- Stage 3 Slow fire, standing, 10 shots in 10 minutes.

## **Rifles Permitted:**

- Springfield: M1903 (except low-numbered) or 1903A3 in "as issued" configuration firing caliber .30-06 ammunition and using original iron sights.
- Military Vintage Bolt Rifles: Any non-US bolt action military rifle of the type used during the WWII era in "as issued" configuration in original caliber and using original iron sights. Including: M1917 Enfield or U.S. Krag Rifle in original "as issued" configuration in original caliber and using original iron sights.
- Garand: M1 Garand in "as issued" configuration firing caliber .30-06 ammunition and using original iron sights.
- Class A Modern Military Rifles: Rifles based on the M-16 or AR design and manufactured by a USA manufacturer must be used. Total rifle weight, with sights and without sling, may not exceed 8.5 lb. No special accurizing is permitted. The rifle must be chambered for the 5.56x45 mm or .223 Remington cartridge.

• Class B Modern Military Rifles: Modern Military Rifles manufactured in the U.S. or another country may be used. The list of allowable rifles include: AK 47, AK 74, SKS, FN-FAL, SVT, HK-91, HK-93, M-14, M1A, and FN-49.

## **Targets:**

• The NRA SR-1 target (the 200-yard SR target reduced for firing at 100 yards) will be used.
